The Native Fishing Association is currently accepting applications for the lease of their Salmon Gillnet Licences. Our salmon licences are vessel-based licences, which must be permanently/temporarily placed on a registered vessel.

General Terms:

- i. The vessel upon which the licence will be placed must be Indigenous owned and operated by an indigenous skipper
- ii. Must have gear already in place or available on applicant's vessel.
- iii. Please be advised that the salmon licence must be used personally by the successful applicant. The licence will only be leased to people who fish it directly and are skipper of the vessel upon which it will be placed.
- iv. Will be required to use the National Online Licensing System (NOLS) to appoint NFA as your representative.
